Entries must have been exhibited theatrically in LA or NY for at least one week during 2013 and must have been written under the WGA MBA or under a bona fide collective bargaining agreement of the Writers Guild of Canada, Writers Guild of Great Britain, Irish Playwrights & Screenwriters Guild, New Zealand Writers Guild, La Guilde Francaise des Scénaristes (France), Scriptwriters Guild of Israel or the Société des Auteurs de Radio, Télévision et Cinéma (Québec) (collectively, "affiliate Guilds"). Submissions for films written under the jurisdiction of an affiliate Guild must include a letter from the affiliate Guild verifying awards eligibility.
