Dear Ms. Andrews:

I'm writing to inquire about the labor relations at ITV. It is my understanding that it has been more than 3 years since the company's producers and associate producers voted to be represented by the Writers Guild of America, East (WGAE) in collective bargaining. I have received complaints that ITV has still not agreed to a collective bargaining agreement, and that, as a consequence, employees still lack basic terms (such as employer-provided health benefits, minimum compensation levels, union security, a grievance and arbitration mechanism, provisions for paid time off, and guaranteed minimum number of days free from work responsibilities when in the field).

I am also concerned about allegations that ITV is not properly compensating overtimeeligible employees for hours they work in excess of 40 per week -- something that is particularly troubling in light of the company's inability to agree to time-off provisions.

Other nonfiction TV production companies in New York have developed productive bargaining relationships with the WGAE and comported their policies to the requirements of federal wage and hour laws. It is my sincere hope that ITV will join them in doing the just thing for its employees.
