The Writers Guild Awards honor outstanding writing in film, television, new media, videogames, news, radio, promotional, and graphic animation categories.

News, Radio, and Promotion categories:
First broadcast or exhibited between Oct. 1, 2012 and Sept. 30, 2013

Theatrical Screenplay Eligibility Period:

Exhibited theatrically in Los Angeles for one week during 2013

<u>Documentary Screenplays</u>:

Exhibited theatrically in Los Angeles or New York for one week during 2013

Videogame Eligibility Period:

Originally released between Dec. 1, 2012 and Nov. 30, 2013
